Why do we need a Committee?

The Twinning Contract requires coordinating processes that involve other Ministries and stakeholders (Activity 4.3).

The NECD requires Member States to draft and report **National Programmes** and to report emissions and projections to the European Commission and the EEA (Article 6).





Twinning Project TR08IBEN02

Overall Purpose is to help,

improving the environmental conditions in Turkey by implementing and enforcing the EU environmental *acquis* in the area of Ambient Air Quality.

Main Objectives

- (1) Strengthen the institutional capacity at the MoEU and cooperation with authorities to transpose the **NEC** Directive towards Improving Emissions Control;
- (2) Preparation of the NEC emissions inventory and projections;
- (3) Development of a strategy and the national programme to abate air emissions.





National Emission Ceilings Directive, 2001/81/EC

Aim is to,

- limit emissions of certain acidifying and eutrophying pollutants and ozone precursor substances (SO₂, NO_x, NH₃ and NMVOC) and,
- effective protect all people against recognised health risks from air pollution.


National Ceilings are,

- consistent with EU and UNECE policy frameworks and,
- based on CBA and modelling undertaken by IIASA.





National Emission Ceilings Directive, 2001/81/EC







What is the Mandate of the Committee?

To draft the National Programme incl. information on adopted and envisaged policies and measures and quantified estimates of their effects on projected emissions.





Which elements are to be considered?

- (1) Transposition of the NECD through a Law under the Turkish Environmental Law;
- (2) Design of a **Emission Abatement Roadmap** for meeting the Emissions Ceilings in (2025);
- (3) Development of the **National Programme** + **Action Plan** based on the nat. Strategy for the implementation of the NECD.





How to set-up the Committee?

- (1) To invite Ministries and stakeholders and, to nominate representatives;
- (2) To organise a meeting in order to initiate the dialogue and the consultation process;
- (3) To identify synergies with the work of the National Climate Change Coordination Board and synchronise action plans and programmes;
- (4) To develop rules and procedures for the Committee;
- (5) To establish working groups;
