




We would like to reach out to you in preparation for our second webinar on 'Engaging with youth on and for sustainability', which will take place on 7 November (10:00-12:00 CET).


As we indicated at our first webinar in June, we would like to focus the November webinar on interactions and practical examples of youth engagement processes. For that purpose, we kindly ask you to send us a short description (max 250 words in a Word document) on the youth engagement process(es) you are / have been running, by 22 September 2023.

Your experience should ideally be related to your work on SoE reporting, but any other youth engagement on environment or sustainability topics are also of interest. Your descriptions do not have to be very polished, and we do not expect you to spend an enormous amount of time on them. Some simple bullet points would also do. We just want to get an impression of what has already been done. You could include aspects such as the type of engagement (e.g. consultation only, full co-creation exercise, etc.), groups of youth involved, the duration, key steps, or impacts of the process.

We will use your short input as a basis to design the webinar on 7 November.

What is Eignet?

The European Environment Information and Observation Network (Eionet) is a partnership network of the C European Environment Agency (EEA) and its 38 member and cooperating countries. EEA and Eionet gather and develop data, knowledge, and advice to policy makers about Europe's environment.

Overall, Eionet consists of the EEA and circa 400 national institutions from 38 countries, with expertise in environmental issues, and eight centres of thematic expertise contracted by the EEA, called European Topic Centres (ETCs).

The EEA is responsible for developing Eionet and coordinating its activities together with National Focal Points (NFPs) in the countries. The NFPs are the country institutions appointed to serve as the primary link between the EEA and the country

NFP administration tools NFPs facilitate and coordinate networks of national experts involved in national activities related to the **E** EEA work programme.

Eionet for the future

The C EEA-Eionet Strategy for 2021-2030 gives the direction for EEA and Eionet in the coming decade. The joint task of EEA and Eionet is to give EU policy makers and the public the best available knowledge to reach the targets on environment and sustainability.



Why the tools will change




- The EEA-Eionet Strategy 2021-2030

- Current custom technology is at the end of its lifecycle. Need for a sustainable, manageable & cost-efficient platform
















The new digital collaboration tools: when and how


- Rollout to all Eionet groups, thematic groups and working groups starts in January 2024
- For remainder of the year, EEA and Eionet continue using current tools
- Schedule of rollout will be announced to countries, via the National Focal Points
- Training in e-learning format for all Eionet members is under development. Expected launch in December
 - > 7 modules
 - Understand the workflows of cooperation activities
 - Select functions of Teams apps to engage in cooperation

Technical requirements to join the new Tools

- Professional email address, to create a Microsoft account
- NOT necessary to install the Microsoft Teams app. Everything can be used through the Browser only.
- Fully supported browsers: Edge and Chrome, up-to-date versions
 - Do not use: Safari, Firefox, Internet Explorer, Opera, etc...
- Multifactor authentication is compulsory
 - Microsoft Authenticator app, smartphone or tablet

Subject: Changes in digital tools used by Eionet as part of Eionet modernisation process

The Eionet modernisation process that kicked-off last year comprises the following areas of intervention: i) revised Eionet structure and profiles of Eionet groups; ii) new working methods; iii) upgrade of digital tools. With this letter, the EEA would like to inform you about the changes that are planned in digital tools and kindly ask for your support in establishing cooperation at the level of the IT department of Eionet institutions of your country to ensure a smooth implementation of these changes.

Why are the digital tools changing?

The current digital tools used for cooperation in knowledge development with Eionet groups have been in place for more than 10 years and have several shortcomings. These limitations were made more salient when Eionet and EEA were working fully online in 2020 and 2021, due to travel restrictions in Europe. To develop the main pillars of a

Microsoft Accounts and federation


When the EEA invites users to log in to EEA's Microsoft Teams, by default the EEA creates guest accounts with the work email address of the user. This triggers an email notification to the user's email address asking the user to join EEA's Microsoft Teams using their work email address.

In most cases, organisations use Microsoft services already, and the user's email address is already federated with Microsoft Azure. In this case, the invitation and redemption process should be straightforward for the user.
