NATIONAL CEAP AND STRATEGIES IN THE EU

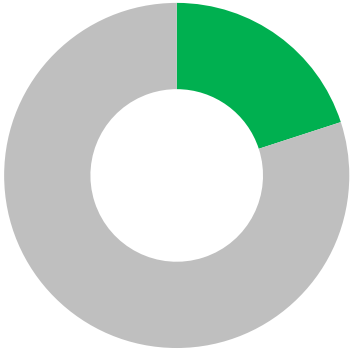


- 15 countries prepared and started to implement their national strategies and action plans.

- Within the scope of the "Technical Assistance for Assessment of Turkey's Potential on Transition to Circular Economy", preparations for the national action plan have been started.

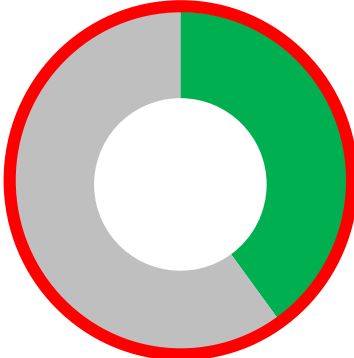
