The Ministry of Environment and Urbanization has received financing from the World Bank for the cost of the Seismic Resilience and Energy Efficiency in Public Buildings Project (SREEPB) and intends to apply part of the proceeds for consulting services.

General Directorate of Construction Affairs (GDCA) of The Ministry of Environment Urbanization and Climate Change (MoEUCC) will serve as the main implementing agency for the Project. The overall objective of the Project is to improve the disaster resilience and energy savings in selected central government buildings, and to strengthen the policy framework and institutional capacity to develop, finance and implement resilient and sustainable public buildings in Turkey. The implementation period for the project is 6 years.

The consulting service (“the Services”) includes the hiring of a full-time **Environmental Specialist** (WB/INDV-ES-02) to support the GDCA's Project Implementation Unit. The selected consultant is expected to be awarded with a one-year renewable contract.

The General Directorate of Construction Affairs now invites eligible individual consultants (“Consultants”) to indicate their interest in providing the Services. Interested Consultants should provide information demonstrating that they have the required qualifications and relevant experience to perform the Services.
